Work Experience in Accidents and Emergency Medicine

Worked at Jordan University Hospital which is the first university teaching hospital in Jordan and one of the first at the level of the Arab world; it provides specialized high quality health care services that implement the international standards. The Emergency Department covers a wide area of the capital city "Amman". It has a bed capacity of 45 beds. The annual emergency visit is 110000, receiving a wide range of cases in all specialties and subspecialties with different age groups and it is considered level one referral trauma center.

A. As a Resident:

First year:

In the Psychiatry clinics I learned how to deal with psychiatric patients in addition to being familiarized with their drug control.

3rd year:

- o Rotation in Anesthesia Department: learning how to secure the airways, to properly manage oxygenation and ventilation, and to secure IV access.
- Rotation in Forensic Medicine: learning the Medico-legal aspects of care, how to write a proper medico-legal reports, and attending sessions in the morgue.
- Three separate rotations in surgical subspecialties: Pediatric Surgery, Neurosurgery and Plastic Surgery: including the operations, meetings, clinics, ward patient management. In Plastic Surgery rotation I attended the Burn Unit to know how to deal with and follow up all types of burn patients. In neurosurgery rotation I attended its ward and the ICU to be exposed to variable cases of head and spine traumas and emergencies and how to deal with them.
- o A one month rotation in the Radiology Department to be familiar with all radiologic modalities and imaging studies used in emergency setting and to

learn who to interpret them.

 One month rotation in Surgical ICU includes: monitoring, following up and managing patients post trauma and post operations.

4th year
